We do these massive children outreaches as a way to reach entire families. Oh how we love to see whole families coming to Jesus! Michele has always said, "If you reach the children you reach the nation!" This has proven to be so very true. In 2019 alone, between our backpack outreach & "VBS of a Lifetime" **93 new churches were planted in Mexico!**

Last years KKC Backpack outreaches were held in **453 different remote mountain communities... 54,259 kids, moms & dads attended... 11,671 people responded to the invitations for salvation... 2,411 of those saved were adults & 49 new churches were planted!!**

After considering all aspects of the project and the impact of Covid-19 we have had to cancel KKC 2020. The churches in the USA have suffered through months of being shut down & we depend so much on their help to promote the project for sponsorships of the 20,000 Christmas Backpacks... Also, the factories in Mexico where we get the 320,000+ products that go into the backpacks were shut down...

We decided to wait and pour all of our energies into making 2021 the greatest year ever for Kingdom Kids Christmas! Donations that come in for KKC during this year will for sure be used for the 2021 KKC Outreach.
