## How are the students chosen?

The student prospects are chosen by their own pastors.

The pastor and each student prospect will go through a four hour interview with Moises, HEA's School of missions Director, and the teaching staff (picture left).

Pastor Lino (left) had brought 3 students. His hope was that they would all three be chosen to be part of the 20 students selected to be in our school. They were in interviews for the entire day, and yes, they were all three chosen and graduated in May 2020 class!!

The Fall 2020 class was canceled due to Covid-19 but the students of the Fall 2021 class are already selected!



Once the decision has been made and the pastors are notified, the pastors, 20 students and parents return to our center for orientation day. We bless their socks off with a special meal, and they leave the students to live with us at the center where they attend classes.

The next couple of days are filled with a lot of logistics (getting the students settled into their dorms, etc). Then, in a special service, Greg begins to challenge them to never give place in their heart to the enemy. After the message is finished the invitation is simple... that they need to leave (on the auditorium floor) everything that could possibly hold them back!!

It's always a heartbreaking day for the HEA Staff as we divide up those who have responded in the invitation and spend the next hour or two listening as they pour their hearts out. Many have been through so much trauma, both

physically and emotionally as well.

## “David’s Story: One of so many from the graduates of HEA’s school”

David wept and cried that day as he shared with Moises how he never felt like God could use him because he had lived in such deep sin in his past. It was a heartbreaking story and they prayed together so much.

When it was all over David got up and left his past there in the auditorium floor!! He has walked in such a glorious freedom in the presence of God ever since!!

David pressed into the school with all of his heart throughout the year, and he has been such an amazing encouragement to us all at HEA since he graduated!! David sent a message recently saying that he wants to come by and share with the HEA Staff some of the amazing things that the Lord has been doing

and how thankful he is that we chose him to be in the school. Glory to God!

Here is a text David sent to Moises...

*Director Moises,*

*I am so very grateful for all that you did for me while I was in the school. Everything that you all do is worth the cost!! Just look at my life now after being in the school. It is not only my life but so many people that knew me in my past life and have heard the story of the change! They have traveled from other places to come and see me because they have heard of how the Lord has transformed my life and that I am serving the Lord now. They come because they just want to see that it is really true! Thank you, David*

We love watching all of our graduates as they return to serve under their own national leaders. It has given us all such joy seeing David grow so much during his time in the school and return to serve his church as their own church planting missionary!

We had put this picture of David’s pastor, Dionicio (below left) in the last newsletter. He took his team out on the trails to the remote mountain community of San Isidro where he wanted to plant a new church...

**San Isidro has a history of being very resistant to the gospel & they persecute preachers who come!**

They were planning an outreach to the children (with supplies from HEA) as a way to reach out to the families.



As they arrived and set up the sound equipment, tarp and chairs (all of which they packed in on the trails), David’s pastor asked him to preach the gospel to the young people who had gathered... Thirteen of them surrendered their lives to Jesus!! (picture below right). They continued going back each week and sharing the gospel door to door in one on one evangelism.



It seemed that the children’s outreaches had helped as some people were beginning to open up to the gospel. On one of their trips back up into the community David was very tired and sat down to rest for a few minutes in front of a small home. A young man came out, and David began sharing the gospel with him. He seemed to be listening very intently, and he began to show interest and sent for his wife to come out and listen also! They said they'd been planning with their leader to do something to them so they would never come back!

But, when they talked to the leader to see what to do, it turned out, to everyone's surprise, that he was the same man who had surrendered his life to Jesus with his wife a little while before!! God had changed his heart!!

In the picture above (right) David is giving the man & his wife the first Bible they ever had!!

They have since allowed David and Pastor Dionicio to have a new mission in San Isidro! Praise God!!
